

Information for Pre-Nursing Students

Spring 2013

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing is a program in which students must apply and be accepted.

Useful information to keep in mind:

- 120 students are selected for the BSN program annually – 60 students for the fall semester and 60 students for the spring semester.
- Selection criteria includes the TEAS test, science GPA, strength of application, letters of recommendation, experience and completion of the prerequisite courses.
- All prerequisites must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.
- Although the minimum cumulative GPA required to apply is 2.70, the average GPA of the students accepted into the BSN program this past year are as follows:

- Cumulative GPA 3.45
- Science GPA 3.24 without repeated sciences
- TEAS TEST 78% on the first attempt

This is a very competitive program!

We encourage all Pre-Nursing students to explore back-up majors/plans.

Pre-Nursing Plans

4-year plan	Must complete pre-reqs. by the end of Spring 2013
4.5-year plan/Spring start	Must complete pre-reqs. by the end of Summer 2013*
5-year plan	Must complete pre-reqs. by the end of Spring 2014 (2 years)

*For Summer 2013 courses at CBU (if considering 4.5-year plan)

- 8-week accelerated pace
- Pre-requisites may not all be offered in the summer
- Courses are often available online only
 - The lab component of lab science courses for all Major/Pre-Nursing requirements must be held in the classroom
- Although the tuition rate is lower in the summer, financial aid is not usually available → Please check with the Financial Aid office regarding your financial aid status
