## Registration Guide for Pre-Nursing Students

#### <u>Step 1:</u>

Using the **Semester Course Offering Guide and Planning Worksheet** on the back, check the **Required Pre-Nursing Requisite Courses** you have completed if you are a <u>Transfer</u> student.

If you are an Incoming Freshman, use the lists on the back to assist you in planning future semesters.

#### <u>Step 2:</u>

Using the Semester Course Offering Guide and Planning Worksheet on the back, check the General Education and additional Nursing courses you have completed.

These courses are <u>not</u> required to be accepted into the Nursing program and may be taken concurrently with Nursing classes. The BSN program will meet all other GE requirements.

### <u>Step 3:</u>

Using the **Semester Course Offering Guide and Planning Worksheet** on the back, plan out how you will <u>complete</u> the Pre-Nursing Prerequisites and when you may apply for the Nursing program.

### **General Information**

For your first semester at CBU:

Provisional students may register up to 13 units.

Standard first-time freshmen students may register up to 16 units (includes FOCUS).

<u>Standard</u> transfer students may register up to 15 units if transferring in less than 24 units; 18 units if transferring in 24 or more units.

Honors students may register up to 18 units.

Students who complete prerequisites by December 31 (fall) may apply for the following fall start.

Students who complete prerequisites by April 30 (spring) may apply for the following fall start.

Students who complete prerequisites by August 31 (summer) may apply for the following spring start.
